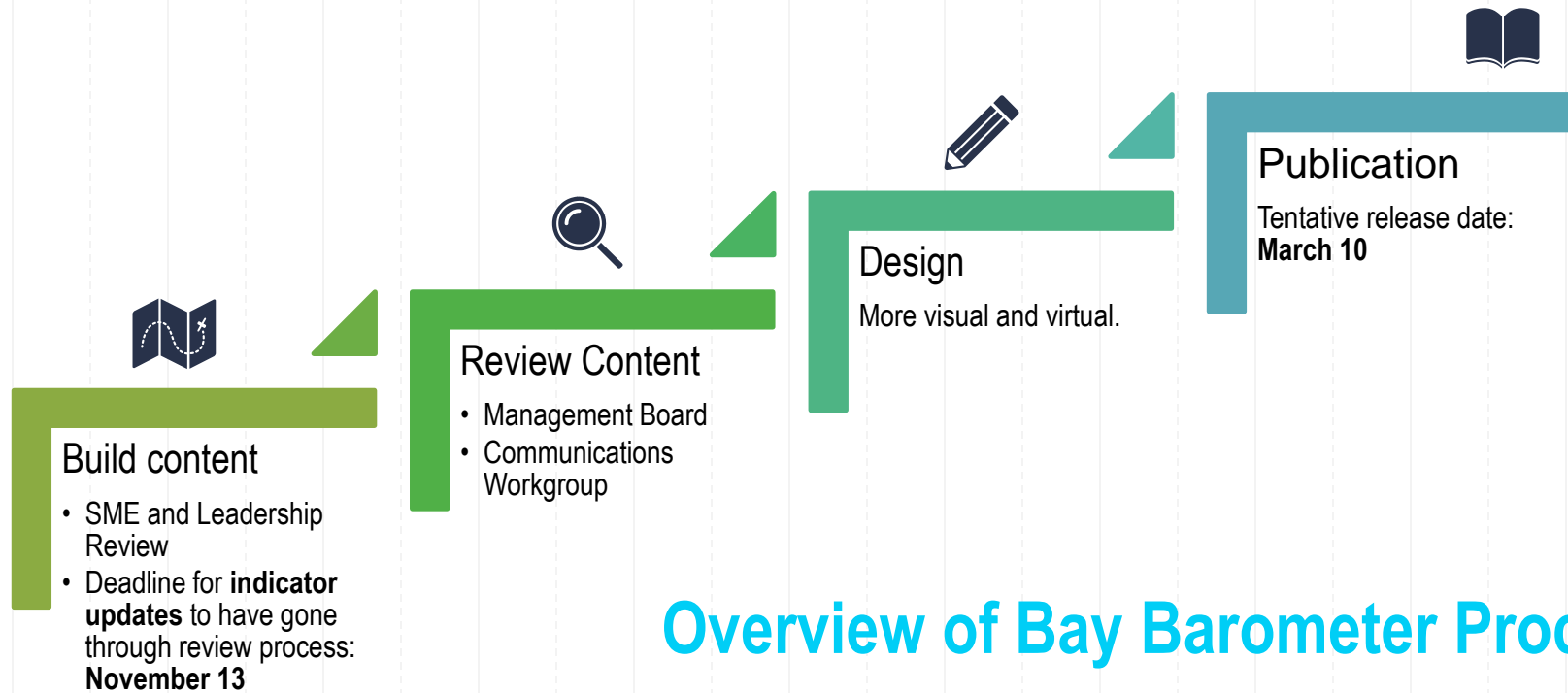

- Story or tip idea

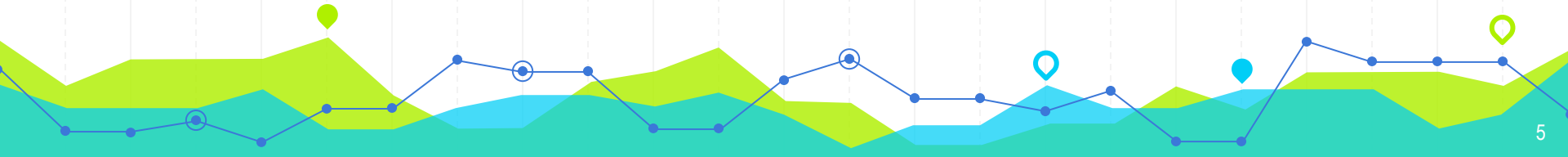


## For Outcomes without Indicators

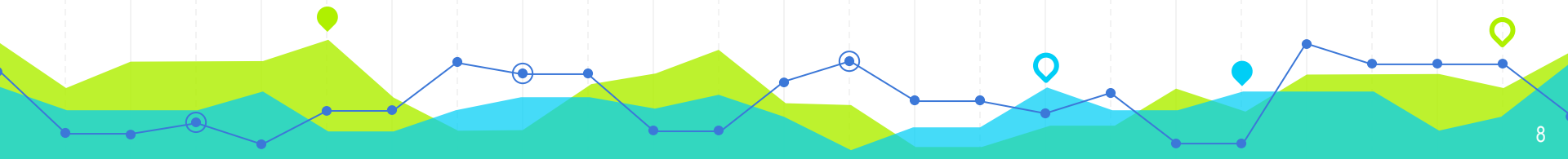
