Chief of the Conservation Division in Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection's Bureau of Conservation & Restoration.

Responsible for environmental regulatory programs for Pennsylvania's 63,000 farm operations, including NPDES CAFO permitting for the largest 370+ farms.

Responsible for financial assistance efforts, including the Chesapeake Bay Implementation Grant, the Growing Greener watershed grant program, and the Section 319 Non-Point Sources grant program.

Responsible for coordination and support of Pennsylvania's 66 county conservation districts.

Previous state government positions included Senior Policy Manager in the Governor's Policy Office for environmental, conservation, agriculture and energy issues and Policy Analyst in Pennsylvania's Department of Environmental Protection and the former Department of Environmental Resources.

Prior to government service, worked for Moyer Packing Company's Rendering Division and Upper Gwynedd-Towamencin Municipal Authority.

Holds degrees in Forest Science and Public Administration from Penn State and a wastewater operator's license.
