Background: In August 2020, during the SRS review for Forest Buffers, the MB agreed to:

- 1) Develop an RFB Action Strategy for each state
- 2) Need to be strategic with existing funds (use existing programs and develop new ones e.g., Natural Filters Revolving Fund)
- 3) Continue to improve technical assistance

<u>"Workshop Your Strategies":</u> Since first proposed, the RFB Attainability Workshop idea has been through several iterations. These iterations had the focus of the workshop be on two things: 1) the state Action Strategies and 2) how to capitalize on the influx of federal funding. After considering our Objectives, we are considering workshopping your Strategies.

- c) ID innovative approaches that could be amplified? (could include changes to existing programs, new programs, ones that could be applied in other states or at a regional or watershed-wide scale to increase the implementation of riparian forest buffers).
- d) Recommendations for new or continued roles the Partnership should play in advancing buffer goals
