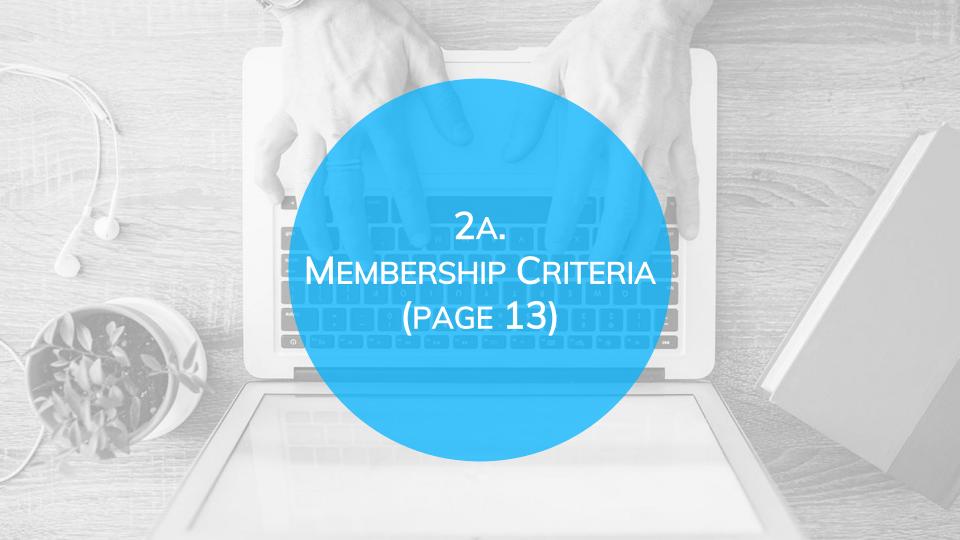




PROPOSED REVISION

- → Added proposed section on "Ethical Behavior Guidelines"
 - Describes expected ethical behavior of all partnership participants,
 - Explains that behavior which seeks to influence CBP decisions for personal gain is unacceptable. Chairs and cochairs need to be particularly sensitive,
 - Identifies actions for suspected violations.









PROPOSED NEXT STEPS FOR REVISION

- → GIT 6 <u>is developing</u> a standard criteria framework and template for all GITs/STAR and Workgroups to be inserted into revised Governance Document
- → GITs will follow this standard membership criteria OR present justification for alternate criteria to GIT 6 and MB for approval



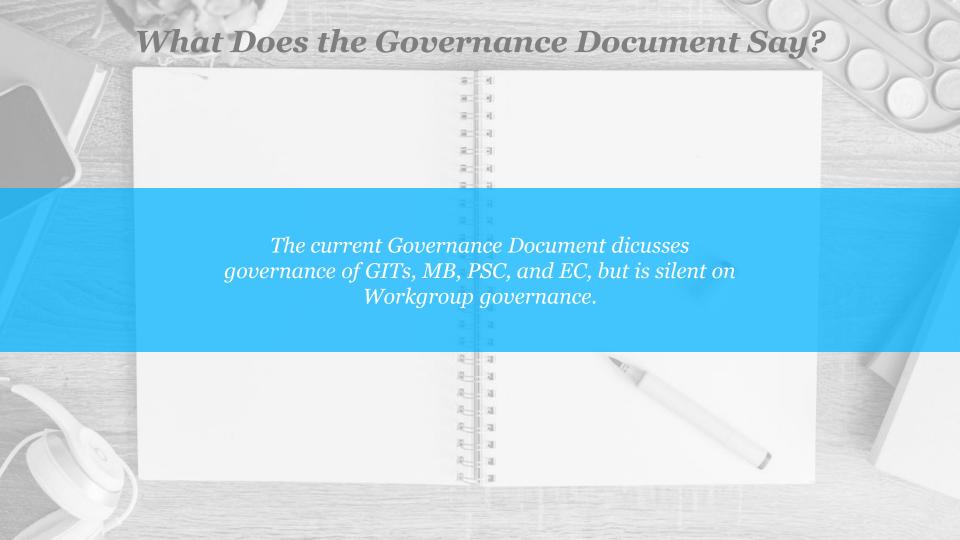




PROPOSED NEXT STEPS FOR REVISION

- → There has been a proposal that GITs and Workgroups maintain separate email (or other) lists for distribution of information:
 - 1. Members
 - 2. Members + interested parties (or interested parties only)
- → Doing so is dependent on clearly defined membership for all groups
- → Recommendation: best addressed by GITs via some guidance, training, or other not directly in Governance Document
 - Ex. Include as part of new staffer onboarding packet





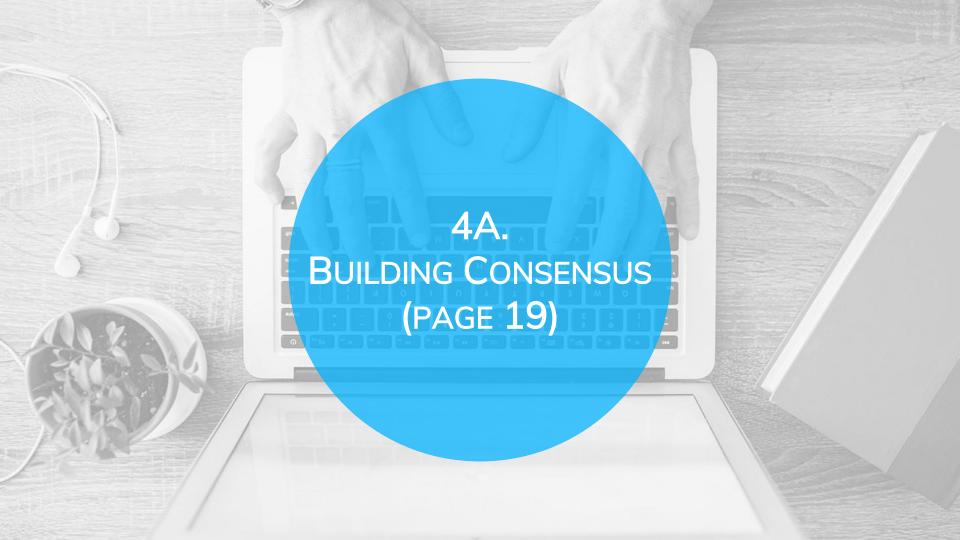


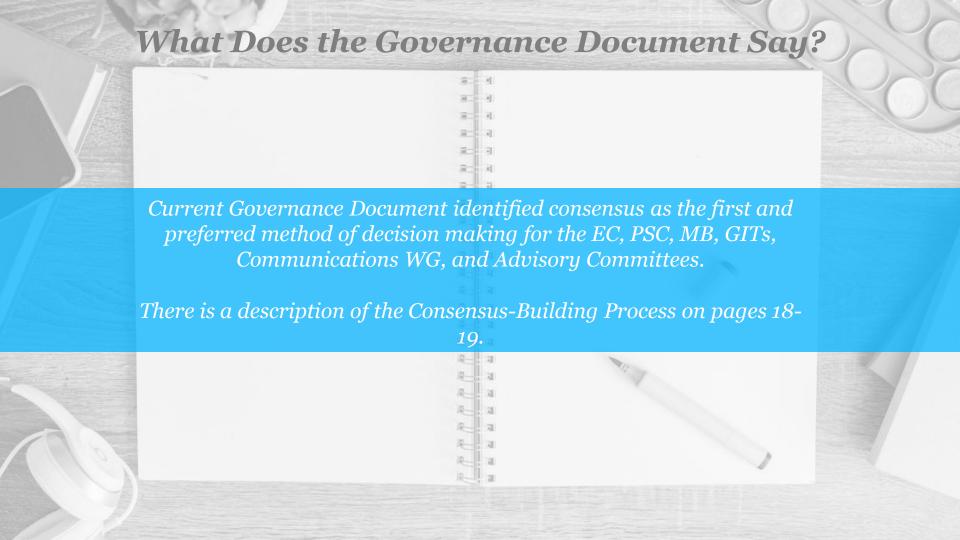
PROPOSED WORKGROUP GOVERNANCE REVISIONS

Workgroups will follow the same governance structure as their GIT, with the following exceptions:

- → Workgroup Chairs do not need to be federal or state employees
- → Non-management level candidates are eligible for Chair
- → Nominees for Chair approved by GIT (not MB)
- → Decisions such as changes in programmatic policy, work plans, or management strategies; proposals for allocation of resources; membership criteria; and leadership nominations should be elevated to the appropriate GIT
- → In cases where a pre-existing external group serves a dual role as a CBP workgroup (e.g. Brook Trout), these CBP workgroup governance guidelines may be modified, and should be determined through collaboration between the workgroup, lead GIT(s), and MB (as appropriate)









PROPOSED NEXT STEPS FOR REVISION

→ GDAT, GIT Chairs, and GIT 6 felt it would be helpful to add the Consensus Continuum graphic to the Governance Document.

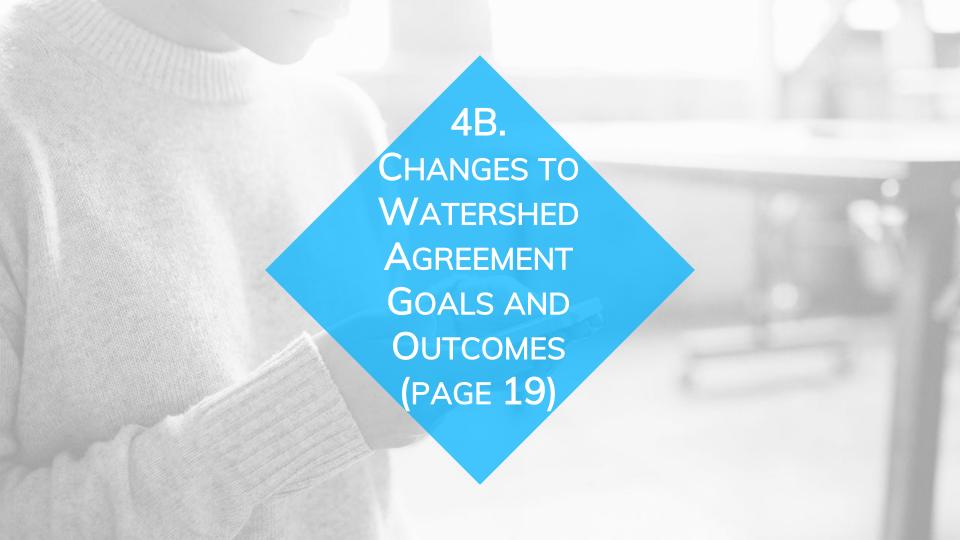

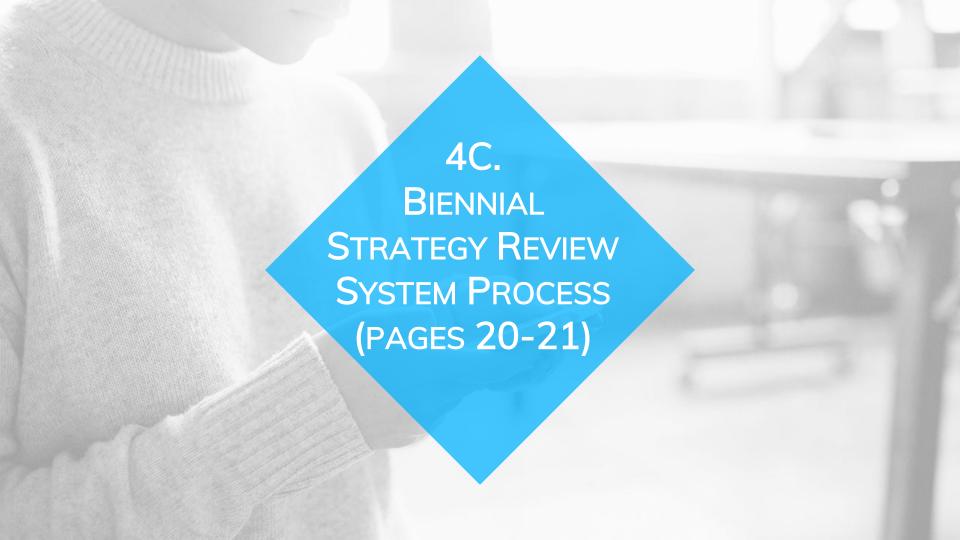


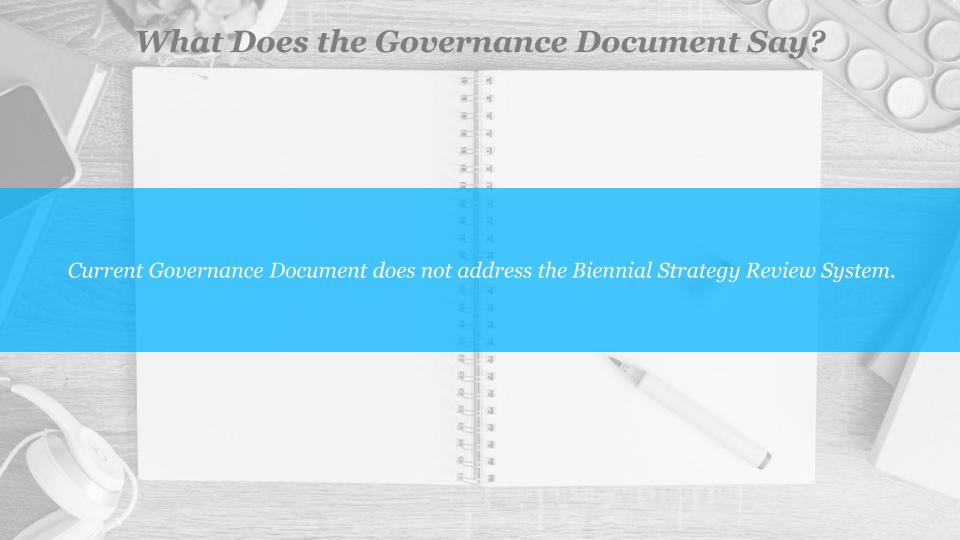




PROPOSED REVISION

→ Add text and graphics discussed in previous agenda item

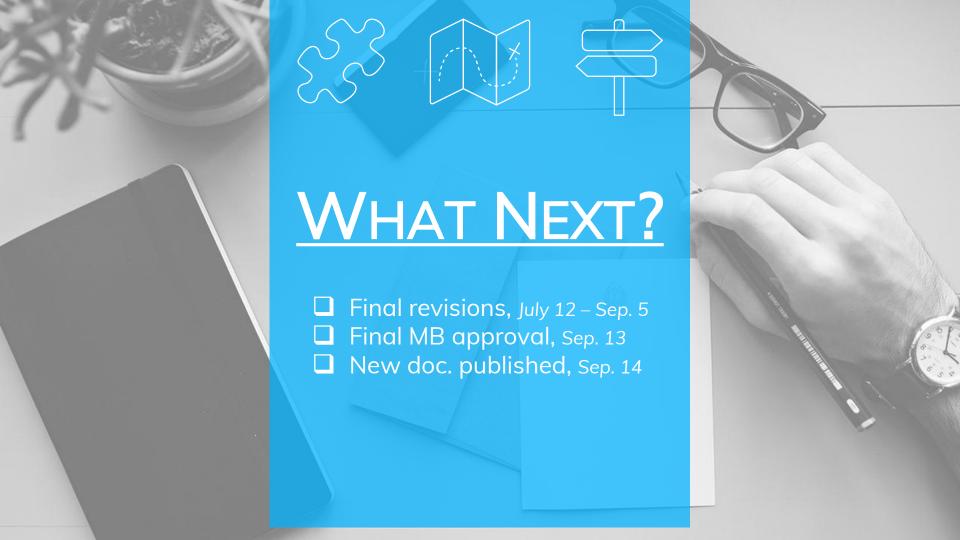






PROPOSED REVISIONS
