The Toxic Contaminant Workgroup (TCW) approved CBP's response to the STAC workshop on Chemicals of Concern (CEC) in Urban and Agricultural Landscapes on July 8, 2020. Several issues were identified through the review process of updated CAST 2019. A draft work plan has been developed that outlines the process, actions, staff leads, and timelines to address these issues to

inform the next version of CAST (2021). The WQGIT Co-chairs will present the draft work plan to ensure it captures all issues raised to date and to address any questions raised by the members.
