2:40 <u>MSWG recommendation to remove 2-year numeric milestones</u> – Dianne McNally, EPA, MSWG Chair (20 min)

Recommendation: Eliminate the expectation for states and federal agencies to develop <u>numeric</u> 2-year milestones under the Chesapeake Bay Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Accountability Framework. Instead, state, and federal agencies will be held accountable to their short-term goals through a biennial evaluation of progress compared to the straight-line trajectory of necessary reductions to the 2025 Phase III planning targets or federal agency planning goals. If a state or federal agency so chooses, numeric 2-year milestones could be developed for the purpose of following an alternative (i.e., non-straight-line) trajectory to 2025. See <u>Figure 7-1</u> of the TMDL document.

Decision Requested: WQGIT approval of raising the recommendation to eliminate state and federal numeric milestones (see above) to the Management Board for decision at their October 17th meeting.
